Info session: Evolution – Nature: a product of chance or the creation of God

Biblical worldview	Evolutionary worldview
God created heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them about 6000 years ago in six 24 hour days.	Belief that life started from non-living chemicals, and during millions of years mutations and natural selection has evolved single-celled creature to e.g. birds, dogs and people.
Genetic entropy (John Sanford, ex-Cornell University professor of genetics) - mutations systematically destroy genetic information - the more the mutations, the less the information - natural selection slows mutational degeneration but cannot stop it	
Evidence fits with perfect creation, which God cursed because of Adam’s Fall and after that creation has been corrupting.	Mutations should be the engine of “molecules-to-man evolution”. The evidence contradicts the belief.
Bacterial flagellum with rotary motor and navigation system	
Science has been able to reveal technology that has a strong message about wisdom of Creator-God of the Bible. Evidence fits with Bible.	4,6 billion years are unable to offer even the needed number of mutations for this very small detail of “molecules-to-man evolution”. The evidence contradicts the belief.
Microevolution – not good term to use - distracts from the key issue of information - biological changes are observed within created kinds - e.g. original dog kind has changed to wolfs, coyotes, dingos and large number of different dog breeds without any information-adding process - animals adapt in different environments - even beneficial mutations are information-losing processes in DNA level	
God created large built-in variation in DNA of original kinds. Evidence fits with perfect creation and information-losing processes followed by the Fall.	Given enough time “microevolution” should lead to “macroevolution”. “Microevolution” is an information-losing process in the DNA level, which cannot help “macroevolution”. The evidence contradicts “molecules-to-man” evolution.
Macroevolution – not good term to use - distracts from the key issue of information - science has not observed any information-adding processes	
Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made (Genesis 2:1-2). Evidence fits with Bible.	In evolutionary belief there should be information-adding mechanism and there should be hundreds of examples all around us. The evidence contradicts the belief.
